

2.2 DISCIPLINE AND ORGANIZATION

The Code of Conduct is outlined in Section 2.3 of this manual. The purpose of the Code of Conduct is to maintain order and discipline on board the vessel.

Company and Ship's Standing Orders, Rules and Regulations expand upon the principles established in the Code of Conduct and provide detailed procedures and guidance for the operation of the ship.

The Master of the vessel (Captain) is the ultimate authority onboard in accordance with International Maritime Law.

The Captain is authorized to order the arrest and confinement of *any person* on board the vessel under his command when he considers a person to be a potential danger to the safety of the vessel, its passengers or crew.

Any necessary confinement of personnel shall be in accordance with national legislation and reasonable in time and terms imposed.
