Job Objective

6. Must report for duty on assigned times following his supervisor's instructions in line with the Company's Rules and Regulations.
7. Required to assist with the transporting of the necessary stock from the Main Store to the messes.

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8. Will be put under a training program to develop his skills in view for a future promotion.
